AMENDMENTS TO THE FIFTH SCHEDULE (EXEMPTION REGIME) OF
THE EAC CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT ACT 2004

LEGAL NOTICE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Council of Ministers by Section 114 (3) of the East African Community Customs Management Act 2004, the Council of Ministers has amended the Fifth Schedule of the Act as follows:

1. Paragraph 14 is amended by inserting the words "and equipment" immediately after the word "reagents"
2. Paragraph 21 is amended by deleting the word "and" appearing after "Furniture" and inserting item "(k) Gymnasium equipment" after item "j".
3. Paragraph 22 is amended by adding a new item "insulated tankers" and numbering them as follows:
 - "(a) Refrigerated trucks
 - (b) Insulated tankers".
4. Paragraph 26 is amended by deleting the word "sealed" appearing immediately after the word "cycle"
5. Insertion of paragraph 29 immediately after paragraph 28 as follows:

"29. Motor vehicles specially designed for refuse/garbage collection and disposal imported or purchased by local authorities or persons contracted by the local authorities to collect refuse/garbage".
