

Kindly clarify what this period of two years means	The period means the duration for which the awarded vendor will support and maintain the system. Note: Bidders are advised to refer to the Price Schedule in the tender document for more clarity



5.	1.1.3 - 5) Integrate to other relevant systems used by the Kenya Revenue Authority. Kindly advice which other systems apart from the ones listed exist?	Other relevant systems are; 1. iCMS – For Customs related data 2. Data Warehouse & Business Intelligence (DW&BI) – Intelligence data 3. Active Directory (AD) – For single sign on authentication 4. Security Information & Event Management (SIEM) – Security logs
5.	1.1.6 The bidder will be required to provide a demonstration of the capabilities of the proposed solution to prove its efficacy as prerequisite to acceptance of the same. QUESTION: - Is this in the course of the evaluation period? - How much notice shall we get to prepare?	In the course of evaluation? Yes. This shall be part of evaluation process -How much notice to prepare? This will be three (3) days from the date of our official notice.
6.	1.1.7 The bidder shall provide concrete proof of ownership of the system. <i>Will a manufacturer's authorization (MAF) be enough proof?</i>	Bidders are advised to include License agreement and Authorization from the manufacturer with unlimited period.
7.	1.2.11.2 Concurrent users The system shall be accessed based on the number of concurrent users, including number of interfaced instruments, and with provision for more users according to need. QUESTION: <i>How many concurrent users does KRA intend and could you provide a list of instruments to be interfaced?</i>	Fifty (50) concurrent users.
8.	Mandatory Requirements: - Power of Attorney (except for sole proprietors). Do we need this for a Limited Company? - 3. Bidders Must submit a Manufacturer Authorization Letter to supply and install the fuel monitoring system to Kenya Revenue Authority. Confirm this is erroneous.	Mandatory Requirements: Power of attorney: Yes, this is a mandatory requirement with exemption to the sole proprietors. 3. Manufacturer letter of authorization: Yes, we need Manufacturer Authorization Letter for supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) as a mandatory requirement. Note; This was an error in the tender document and has been addressed in Addendum 1 dated 15th June 2022.
9.	Post Qualification Evaluation on page 44 on the tender document:	Bidders are advised that this requirement has been amended to read: 



KRA shall carry out due diligence to ascertain the bidders past performance.	KRA will conduct site visit(s) to any or all the provided reference sites. The bidder will be required to facilitate/organize the visit to any such chosen site(s) forming substantive responsiveness.
