In Page 86 at section VI: Tender Security of KES. 500,000 valid for 365 days from tender opening closing date (i.e 3 <sup>rd</sup> June 2021)	Kindly clarify on:  If every LOT should have its own BID SECURITY.	Bidders are required to provide only one bid security of KES. 500,000 valid for 365 days from tender opening closing date (i.e 3 <sup>rd</sup> June 2021) irrespective of the no. of Lots they are bidding for.
In page 107 at section VII: Price schedule for LAN Installation Services (Labour Only) Lot 4	The generator hiring on page 107 that’s for 40 hours;  1. what is the size of the generator? 2. Is the destination within Nairobi or outside Nairobi.?	Since the successful bidder would be required to provide LAN installation services in any existing or new KRA office located in any of the 47 counties, the contractor might experience some power failures in some of the remote sites while in the process of installing/ testing the LAN. This is therefore just provision for hiring a generator in the event of a power failure and the Contractor needs power to do their work or test the service they have installed. It is important to note that the successful bidder may not even encounter a power failure in any of the sites and in that case, the need to hire a generator would not arise. This is just a safeguard put in



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		<p>place to ensure that Power failure cannot be the reason for failing to complete the project within the agreed timelines</p> <p>#</p> <p><b>1. what is the size of the generator?</b> <b>Answer:</b> Small generator just enough to power LAN equipment (switches), drilling machines etc in the event of power failure on site.</p> <p><b>2. Is the destination within Nairobi or outside Nairobi.?</b> <b>Answer:</b> To be hired locally or on site in the event of power failure and there is a need for power on site.</p>
