Can the past experience of our manufacturing partners be sufficient to fulfil this requirement? | Prospective bidders are advised that the past experience from manufacturing partners is acceptable to support this requirement as long as the bidder can proof having partnered with the manufacturer in supply of drones. For this case, the bidder should attach an agreement between them and the manufacturer in the supply of drones to their respective client(s). Additionally, by allowing JV with foreign partners/firms will enable fulfilment of the requirements. |
