OUTSOURCED TEA/CATERING SERVICES TO VARIOUS KRA STATIONS**

Kenya Revenue Authority wishes to inform prospective bidders of the clarifications for the above referenced tender.

ITEM No.	QUESTIONS/ISSUES	KRA'S RESPONSE
1.	Will the evaluation for pricing be done wholesomely for each LOT or will it be done per work station?	Pricing evaluation will be done on a lot basis as captured on your Form of Tender (page 36) and summary of the same as per the totals in the Price Schedule (page 32 and 33)
2.	Can I bid for say, 2 office stations in LOT1?	Bidders are expected to bid for all the offices within a lot as detailed in the Price Schedule on Page 32 and 33 of the tender document. Failure to bid for a line item (office) within a lot will be considered non-responsiveness.
3.	On the pricing, are we supposed to put cumulative cost for the three lots or the system can be programmed so that we put in the cost per LOT?	The system allows you to only input one price. Bidders are expected to input the total price for all lots participated in. However, the evaluation and award will be done on a lot-by-lot basis, as per the submitted Form of Tender as detailed on page 36 of the tender document.
4.	Is the tender open to other AGPO groups. i.e. Youth and PLWD?	The tender is strictly Reserved for Women-Owned Enterprises under AGPO. Certification that it is women-owned is a MANDATORY requirement.
5.	What is the security of the bids already submitted?	The integrity of the system is 100% guaranteed. The system records un-editable and verifiable time and date stamps for any information submitted. Bidders are however encouraged to ensure that their submitted bid has a status of submitted especially if they edited/changed their bid after the extension.

This clarification forms part of the bidding document and is binding to all bidders. All other terms and conditions of the tender remain the same.
