KRA wishes to inform prospective bidders of the clarifications highlighted below;

No.	Bidders Questions	KRA's Response
1	In the evaluation criteria it states that bidders must attach CV of their directors who must have technical qualifications. In cases of foreign companies with foreign directors whose identity is protected by law can a firm attach a CV of their local directors	Bidders are advised to attach a CV and relevant certificates of a technical resource who has been duly nominated by the company to discharge the duties of a director.
2	On page 91 it states that the bidders should provide for maintenance of the existing lift. -this item should be omitted as the lifts are not serviceable.	This has been expunged and will not form part of the scope of works.
3	The BQ need to be revised on the dayworks elements (Labor, Materials and equipment) pages 81-84 as they have no description and quantity thus will lead to an unlevel pricing field. Alternatively, the dayworks items should not be carried to the summary Include a provisional sum in the BQ for refurbishment of the machine room just paintworks and reinforcement of the cat ladder though the proposals maybe for a machine less room the headroom at the upper floor may not be enough	The BQ will not be revised and bidders are advised to price all the items contained in the tender BQ Bidders are advised that contingency sum has already been provided for in the BQ that will be spent on instruction from the project manager.
4	A decision needs to be made on where to store the lift materials after removal pending disposal by Supply Chain Management	Bidders will be required to handover the dismantled lift parts of the old lift including an itemized list of the items to the client for storage at an area on the ground floor parking of the building
NB: bidders are reminded that the tender validity is 335 days and this should be indicated in the Form of Tender ie <i>We agree to adhere by this tender for a <u>period of 335 days</u>, and it shall remain binding upon us and may be accepted at any time before that date</i>		

The Clarification/addendum form part of the bidding document and is binding to the bidder. All other terms and conditions of the tender remain the same. You are therefore required to immediately acknowledge the receipt of this addendum.
