PREFACE

The Simplified Certificate of Origin (SCO) User Guide is an East African Community (EAC) publication which is aimed at creating awareness among cross border traders on how to access and use the SCO. It answers questions on what an SCO is, its benefits to cross border traders, eligible products that can be cleared using the SCO, and practical steps towards access and application of the SCO.

The user guide is aimed at creating knowledge among the cross border traders on the simplified trade facilitation measures that the EAC Council has taken with a view to promoting duty free intra-regional trade of eligible products which are traded across the EAC borders with value not exceeding United States Dollar (US)\$2,000.

The User Guide has been prepared with support from United States Agency for International Development (USAID) East Africa Trade Hub (EATH), a regional program whose aim is to enhance trade competitiveness in East and Central Africa.

What is East African Community (EAC) Simplified Certificate of Origin (SCO)?

The EAC Simplified Certificate of Origin (SCO) allows customs officials in the destination country not to charge import duty on exports that are accompanied by the SCO. It is issued at the customs border offices by customs officials for all exports of a value not more than United States Dollar (US)\$2,000 that have been produced in any of the EAC Partner State.

What benefits does one get in using the SCO?

The key benefit for using the SCO to clear goods of a value not more than United States Dollar (US)\$2,000 is waiver of import duty. This reduces cost of the goods being traded significantly and makes it easy to sell more of the goods in the destination market.

Which products qualify to be cleared through the Simplified Certificate of Origin?

Exports and imports of all products that appear in the attached list qualify for being cleared using the SCO. These include all agricultural produce such as maize, beans, bananas, potatoes and many more. For instance if you are exporting maize from Uganda to Kenya whose value is not more than US\$2,000 you can get the SCO at the Uganda customs offices at the border. Once you get to Kenya Customs Offices at the border and produce the SCO, they will not charge import duty on the maize.

What do I pay Customs in order to get the SCO?

SCOs are issued free of charge at the customs offices at the borders.

Am I required to use a Clearing Agent to fill in the SCO?

No. The form is so simple that a trader does not need any assistance to fill it in. Customs Officers offer free service in assisting any trader who may be unable to fill the certificate. Periodic trainings conducted at gazetted borders by Customs will help new entrants in cross border trading to familiarize with completing the SCO.

What steps do I follow to ensure successful access and use of the SCO?

Step 1

When preparing your export consignment ensure the consignment has a value of not more than US\$2,000 in order for it to be eligible for clearance using the SCO.

Step 2

On arrival at the border, walk to the Customs Offices and check at the Notice Board whether the goods you are exporting are in the list of eligible products.

You can also check in advance whether the goods are eligible in the EAC website or the EAC Trade Help Desk Portal (<http://tradehelpdesk.eac.int/>). If they are, then proceed and request the form from the customs officer on duty.

Step 3

Following the guide notes below fill in the required details in Simplified Certificate of Origin. A sample of this certificate is attached to this booklet for ease of reference.

Each box on the Simplified Certificate of Origin is identified using a numeral (i.e. 1, 2, 3 etc). The exporter should correctly fill all the information required so as to avoid delays.

The instructions on how to complete the form are shown below:

Box 1. Name of Exporter

Fill in the full names and address of the person/company exporting/supplying the product.

Box 2. Port of Clearance

Fill in the name of the port or border post where goods are being cleared.

Box 3. Name of Importer

Fill in the full names and address of the person/company importing the product.

Box 4. Identification of Transport

Fill in the means being used to transport the products e.g. vehicle, motor cycle, bicycle etc.

Box 5. Goods Description

Fill in the name of goods being exported/imported. Refer to the list of eligible goods for the correct description of goods

Box 6. Quantity

Fill in the quantity of the products, e.g. number of drums, crates, boxes etc

Box 7. Net Weight

Fill in the total weight of the goods in Kilograms

Box 8. Country of Origin

Fill in the name of the country where the goods originating.

Box 9. Country of Destination

Fill in the country to which you are going and where the goods will be finally sold.

Box 10. Value

Fill in the value of goods being exported/imported

Box 14. Declaration by Exporter/Importer

- Fill in the name of the person or company exporting/importing the product
- Sign at the space provided for signature
- Give the name of the place where the product is being exported from at the space provided for the place.
- Fill in the date when this certificate is filled in at the place provided for the date.
- For companies, stamp the form at the place provided for official stamp.

(C) Other Boxes

Boxes falling under the header **“FOR OFFICIAL USE”** and **“REVENUE INFORMATION”** shall be completed by Customs officials
