1	<p>Kindly clarify on requirement for 67x Optical Zoom for the EO/IR Camera.</p> <p>The optimal zoom would be 30x zoom, as the price for a 67x EO/IR camera supersedes the price of the UAS (Drone) itself.</p>	<p>KRA requirements holds. Prospective bidders are advised to respond as per the requirements spelt out in the tender document.</p>
2	<p>KRA requires evidence where supplier has supplied drones and are operational.</p> <p>Our manufacturer has signed NDA's with their clients and it's impossible to share POs and references concerning the supply of drones. Most of the clients are highly secured/ strictly censored establishments taking care of their respective national securities thus such information is considered classified. Can we provide our past experience for the broader security equipment/systems and commitment letter from our manufacturer?</p>	<p>Prospective bidders are advised that where a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) exists with their manufacturer or clients, they should provide copies of the respective contracts without indicating the name of the client and the contract value. Where a bidder has indicated NDA agreement exists and is considered the lowest evaluated bidder, then KRA shall require disclosure of their client(s) for the purposes of carrying out due diligence.</p>

- Note this being the final addendum/clarification to be issued.
- The closing date will be on **3rd June 2022 at 11:00 AM**
