<u>CLAIMING OF INSURANCE RELIEF IN THE INCOME TAX RESIDENT</u> (ITR) RETURN FOR PERIOD 2022

The Finance Act 2021 amended section 31 of the Income Tax Act to allow contributions to NHIF to qualify for Insurance Relief effective 1st January 2022.

Resident taxpayers filing the Income tax Resident (ITR) return for 2022 are guided as follows:

- 1. Upon filing of the return (either excel form and web based ITR), the user should select 'Yes' to the question 'Do You Have an Insurance Policy'
- 2. Proceed to capture the NHIF details under the iTax 'Insurance Relief sheet' as follows:

For this option, one should type the letters 'ID', enter space, then proceed to capture the ID number e.g. ID 12345678
